Information for Runners	<ul> <li>Competitors must download regardless of whether they have completed their course.</li> <li>Competitors must be considerate and aware of pedestrians, members of the public and other runners; in particular, competitors must be cautious in congested or constricted areas of the town and when turning blind corners.</li> <li>Competitors must take care when running alongside the river or canal; only cross the canal or the river at recognized bridges.</li> <li>Competitors must take care with vehicle traffic for their own safety, and that of other road users.</li> <li>Competitors must take care crossing roads; where there is the option to use a crossing point (eg zebra crossing) competitors should do so.</li> <li>Competitors must use the underpass under the section of the A386 that is marked as an uncrossable boundary. This is between the canal bridge (New Fitzford Cottages junction) and college turning.</li> <li>Competitors must not enter buildings, private property or other out of bounds areas. Competitors must not cross walls, fences, railings or other boundaries marked as impassable.</li> </ul>
